# **NWIFCA Netting Permit Flexible Permit Conditions**

The technical permit conditions:

### **Interpretations**

In the following flexible permit conditions:

"drift net" means a net which remains throughout the entirety of its use free of any contact with any part of the foreshore or seabed or any object or structure thereon or therein;

"fishing" includes searching for sea fisheries resources, shooting, setting, towing, hauling, of a fishing gear, and taking sea fisheries resources on board

"Crustacea"

"Fixed net" means a net that comes into contact with any part of the foreshore or sea bead or any structure thereon or therin

"Flue net"

### 1. Catch Restrictions

As provided by paragraph 22(a) of the North Western IFCA Netting Permit Byelaw, the following permit conditions apply:

1.1 No Crustacea may be retained from a net

### 2. Gear Restrictions

As provided by paragraph 22(a) of the North Western IFCA Netting Permit Byelaw, the following permit conditions apply:

- 2.1 Mesh must not measure less than 89mm
- 2.2 Category two permit holders can use an aggregate of 400m of nets
- 2.3 Category three permit holders can use an aggregate of 100m of net
- 2.4 No net shall be set either from a boat or the shore within 200m of another net
- 2.5 No net shall be set across a channel or in the use of a beach set net touch the edge of a stream or channel at low water
- 2.6 A Flue net issued under a category two permit must;
  - a) Not exceed 75m across its headline
  - b) Elapsed time between shooting the net and hauling must not exceed 30 minutes
  - c) A net shall be actively worked by splashing during the operation
  - d) Only one net shall be carried or used at any time

### 3. Spatial conditions

As provided by paragraph 22(a) of the North Western IFCA Netting Permit Byelaw, the following permit conditions apply:

### **ANNEX B**

- 3.1 In the areas defined by coordinates set out in the attached annex 1 of this permit a permit holder is not authorised to use a net within the time period set out in paragraph 4.1
- 3.2 A Whitebait filter net issued two a Category two permit holder under the grandfather rights clasue stipulated in prargraph XX of this byelaw bay only be used in Areas 8,9, & 10.

### 4. Time Restrictions

As provided by paragraph 22(a) of the North Western IFCA Netting Permit Byelaw, the following permit conditions apply:

4.1 A permit holder or named representative is not authorised to use a net in any of the defined areas set out in Annex 1 or this permit between XXXX and XXXX dates
