# **REVISION OF STANDING ORDERS**

Recommendation:

- 1. Members approve and adopt the revised Standing Orders at Annex A.
- 2. Members approve and adopt the Scheme of Delegation at Annex B.
- 3. Standing Orders or other parts of the Constitution of the Authority may be amended in accordance with the provisions of the introductory section of the revised Standing Orders.

#### Background

- 1. Member Mr. Leigh has produced further versions of the NWIFCA Standing Orders and Scheme of Delegation based on comments made at the June Annual Meeting and subsequent comments from members.
- 2. Mr Leigh has summarized the amendments to Standing Orders as follows:
  - 1. Opening paragraph concerning Standing Orders has been moved out of Section 1 to a stand-alone provision (to avoid a re-numbering exercise).
  - 2. Section 1.1 membership details have been corrected.
  - 3. Section 1.6 Suspension provisions concerning serious complaints has been removed.
  - 4. Section 3.1 The notice period with reference to the appointment of Chair has been amended.
  - 5. Section 3.2 amendments to the role of Chair
  - 6. Section 3.11 Amendments with reference to the process of electing a new Chair in the event of resignation, removal or termination of membership of previous role incumbent.
  - 7. Section 4.3 Amendments with reference to Vice-Chair (replicating 3.11 above)
  - 8. Section 8.5 Amendments concerning issuing of draft minutes.
  - 9. Section 9.2 Inclusion of "Matters Arising" and amendments with reference to purpose of reports.
  - 10. Section 11.3 amendments with reference to membership of the General Purposes and Standards Sub-Committee.
  - 11. Section 11.8 simple numbering change

3. Mr Leigh's summary of the amendments to the Scheme of Delegations is as follows:

## **Full Authority Responsibilities and Functions**

- 2. Amended order of functions of full Authority to emphasise approval of Annual Plan and Strategic Policy Framework
- 3. Amended order of functions of full Authority to emphasise its role in monitoring delivery of Annual Plan and Strategic Policy Framework
- 15 Inclusion of the ability to delegate decision making powers to a sub-committee or officers as appropriate
- 16. Inclusion of the ability to reach decisions by email poll. A measure I would expect only to be used on a minority of occasions

#### General Purposes and Standards Sub-Committee

- 1. Minor amendment to include 'consideration and'
- 4. Inclusion of power to delegate its powers to officers in appropriate cases
- 5. Inclusion of the ability to reach decisions by email poll. A measure I would expect only to be used on a minority of occasions

### Finance and Personnel Sub-Committee

- 3. Confirmation of financial limit reference disposal of assets
