Background

- 1. Members of the Technical, Science and Byelaw Committee are appointed at each Annual Meeting of the NWIFCA.
- 2. The terms of reference from both the existing and revised Standing Orders currently under consideration are:-

"The Technical, Science and Byelaw Sub-Committee shall have 10 Members made up of Environment Agency, Natural England and Marine Management Organisation representatives and 7 other members elected by the NWIFCA at each Annual General Meeting. It shall consider all matters of a scientific nature and the making and revision of byelaws and shall have plenary powers to act on urgent matters.

Any other NWIFCA member may attend this Sub-Committee but must inform the Clerk one week before the meeting. They may receive papers on request and may speak but not vote at the meetings.

The Sub-Committee is permitted to co-opt additional specialist expertise from within the Authority to address technical issues."

- 3. The Chairman and Vice-Chairman are ex-officio members of the TSB Committee.
- 4. A list of all eligible MMO appointees has been circulated and a postal ballot held. The outcome of the ballot will be tabled at the meeting.
