BYELAW 11 - MARKING OF NETS AND LINES.

Byelaw confirmed 22.08.03

A person must not use in fishing for seafish any set or stake net or line except in accordance with the following regulations;

- (a) The site of the stakes, nets or lines shall be marked by substantial buoys, non-metallic poles or perches visible above the surface at any state of the tide and such buoys, poles or perches shall be maintained as long as the stakes or nets are in position.
- (b) The owner's name, vessel number or other identifying mark shall be clearly displayed on or attached to at least one buoy, pole or perch.
- (c) No portion of a stake net shall be nearer the centre of any stream or channel than the edge of such stream at low water of the tide during which the net is fishing.
- (d) No portion of any net shall be nearer than 137.5 metres to any portion of another net not being a hose net or moored whitebait filter net.
- (e) No net shall exceed 275 metres in length.
